






# WELCOME TO HRD AUCTION ROOMS LTD

'Bears signature' ... in our opinion there is an element of doubt over the signature or it has been added by another hand.

#### DROITE DE SUITE OR ARTISTS RESALE RIGHT

In accordance with the Artists Resale Rights Regulations 2006, all lots marked '(d/s)' which sell for 1000 Euros or more are subject to a resale royalty charge, payable by the bidder. This royalty will be charged at a rate of 4% of the hammer price for lots selling above 1000 Euros. For lots selling above this figure the fee is calculated on a sliding scale.
